

Making the most of the tech boom, the Viceroy Group opened its first property in San Francisco in 2013, taking over the former Hotel Milano. Following a \$13m revamp, it's now a brogrammers' paradise, kitted out with a mezzanine gaming room, Jambox speakers and bluetooth TVs, as well as retro-nostalgic decor — look out for the pop-art portraits made from floppy discs. The 116 guest rooms (Premier Studio

King, above) were transformed into urban lofts by the Seattle-based Dawson Design Associates. Book a suite and you'll have access to a wet bar, Nintendo Wii U games, and vinyl to play on Crosley turntables.
