Hot Openings: From scrap to treasure in San Francisco

Hotel Zephyr Fisherman's Wharf in San Francisco was designed by Dawson Design Associates with unconventional materials. Recycled corrugated metal and cargo containers as well as upcycled nautical materials and shipping crates were used to transform the former Radisson Fisherman's Wharf into the edgy, maritime theme hotel that re-opened in May.

The waterfront hotel features 361 guestrooms and suites, with many rooms offering personal balconies. Guests are encouraged to gather in communal areas that feature games, social activities and lounging alongside fire pits.

“Our design team’s inspiration grew from capturing the spirit of rough and rowdy sailors and infusing thematic elements throughout the hotel to create the fresh spirit of Hotel Zephyr,” said Andrea Dawson Sheehan, CEO and art director at Dawson Design Associates.
